



# Czech Open Golf Tour 2021

## The Terms of the Competition

---

- 1. Status:** two **open tournaments** for professional and amateur male players
- 2. Eligibility:** professionals regardless of their citizenship; amateurs with Czech citizenship who are members of Czech Golf Federation affiliated clubs. In doubt an amateur must certify his Czech citizenship by submitting ID documents or passport
- 3. Rules of Golf:** both tournaments shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by the R&A Rules Limited, the Czech Golf Federation Hard Card and Local Rules as approved by the respective Committee in charge

*Note 1: If a player qualifies to more than one exemption category he is always referred to in the higher(est) one*

*Note 2: The promoter reserves the right to adjust the number of accepted professionals and amateurs to the actual entries*

*Note 3: The promoter reserves the right to limit the number of foreign professionals to one third of all professionals in the field*

- 10. Entry fee:** 100 EUR per event; includes on-course refreshment on all tournament days, practice round prior to the first tournament day (i.e., on June 24, 2021; on September 2, 2021), unlimited practice balls on the practice day and on all tournament days
- 11. Winner:** player with the lowest gross score over 54 holes; if there is a tie for the 1st place the winner will be determined by a Sudden-Death Play-Off which will start as soon as the last group has completed the final round. The play-off will be played on Hole 18 at both venues; repeatedly if necessary to determine the winner
- 12. Prize money:** 250.000 CZK (10.000 EUR) per event. The prize money will be divided among Top 10 players including (not skipping!) amateurs. The prize money breakdown shall be as follows (from the 1st to the 10th place): 26,5%; 17,0%; 13,0%; 10,0%; 8,5%; 7,0%; 6,0%; 5,0%; 4,0%; 3,0%
- Note 4: Only professionals in Top 10 will be paid prize money after each event in 2021*
- Note 5: Amateurs in Top 10 will be awarded prizes complying with the Rules of Amateur Status.  
**The best finishing amateur at Kaskáda will win the playing card for the 2021 D+D Real Czech Masters, European Tour, August 19-22, Albatross, Prague***
- Note 6: Only for the purpose of awarding prizes to amateurs in Top 10 in both 2021 COGT events the scorecards from the final round will be matched for the last 18, 9, 6, 3, 1 holes (or by lot) to break a tie*
