

LOCAL RULES

The **CGF Hard Card 2019** is in effect with the following addendums:

- 1. Out of Bounds** is defined by white lines and stakes, or the fence rounding the course.
Note: Electric fence by itself is not a boundary object.
- 2. Penalty Areas:** All Penalty Areas on the course are red and are marked by red lines and stakes.
- 3. Immovable Obstructions:** All objects as per definition, including:
 - All artificially surfaced roads and paths including immediately affected damaged ground
 - Wooden reinforcements in the banks of bunkers
 - Ant hills
 - All parts of the electric fence (in bounds)
 - Poles of electric wiring
- 4. Young Trees Protection:** Trees with supporting stakes are ground under repair and a no play zone. If such a tree interferes with lie of the ball or players stance or area of intended swing the player must take free relief.
- 5. Ground under Repair :** All objects as per Hard Card, including:
 - Areas marked by white lines or blue stakes
 - Drainages including their remnants
 - Washouts in bunkers
 - Cracks in the ground (except when interfering with the player's stance only)
- 6. Preferred Lies:** When a player's ball lies in a part of general area cut to **fairway** height or less the player may take free relief once by placing the original ball or another ball in and playing it from this relief area:
Reference Point: Spot of the original ball.
Size of Relief Area Measured from Reference Point: Length of the grip of the club except putter, but with these limits:
Limits on Location of Relief Area: Must not be nearer the hole than the reference point and must be in the general area.
- 7. Bare Spots Relief:**
Bare Spot is a spot without grass or with only dried or dead grass which is sunk under the level of adjacent **mowed** ground.
When a player's ball lies on a bare spot in general area except in a non-mowed part (high rough, woods) the player may take free relief once the same way as in **preferring lie** (see 6).
Exception: The player **may not** take relief under this local rule when his or her stance or area of intending swing is anyhow interfered by a growing tree, bush or non-mowed rough
