



INSTRUCTIONS FOR PLAYERS

1. **Players have to register at the reception and pay the entry fee in cash before commencing the first round.** The entry fee amounts to 900 CZK (or 40 EUR). Players will receive scorecard for the first qualification round and information package, local rules and the current edition of the CGF Hard Card.
2. Scorecard for the second qualification round as well as Pin Positions and Local Rules and the current edition of the CGF Hard Card will the players receive at the first tee.
3. After each round the players have to return the completed and signed score cards at the designated Scoring Area immediately. Players shall bring their score cards personally so that any potential rules issues can be settled with Chief referee.

The Scoring Area is located in the reception and is distinctively marked.

Once the player leaves the Scoring Area his/her score card is deemed to be returned.

To avoid mistakes it is advisable that players sum up the total result on the score card (though he/she is not responsible for the correctness of the sum) and check their scores on the score board afterwards or on-line scoring.

4. The qualification is deemed to be closed once the draw for the match play phase commences.
5. In the Match Play phase the players will receive both the scorecard and Pin Positions at the first tee.
6. The Match Play result must contain distinctively stated final score, indication of the winner and signatures of both players. The result (card) shall be reported (returned) at the reception desk or handed over to the Chief referee of the Championship.
7. If the match stands All Square through 18 holes it is prolonged by as many holes as necessary to identify the winner, commencing from the hole No 1 as in the stipulated round.
8. In all competition rounds there will be refreshment (**1 pcs of fruit and 2 bottles of water**) available at the first tee. No refreshment is being provided during the practice round.

Other boarding is up to the individual players.
