



EVACUATION PLAN

In case of suspension/resumption of play by the Committee the respective signals will be emitted from the clubhouse as well as from the cycle track rounding the course. The following signals will be used:

Immediate suspension of play: One prolonged note of siren

Suspension of play: Three consecutive notes of siren, repeated

Resumption of play: Two short notes of siren, repeated

When play is suspended by the Committee for a dangerous situation, if the players in a group are between the play of two holes, they must not resume play until the Committee has ordered a resumption of play. If they are in the process of playing a hole, they must discontinue play immediately and not resume play until the Committee has ordered a resumption of play. If a player fails to discontinue play immediately, she is disqualified, unless circumstances warrant waiving the penalty as provided in Rule 33-7.

When play is suspended by the Committee the players shall follow the following instructions depending on their current location:

C ... go directly to the Clubhouse

Ex ... leave the course to the cycle track by the Exit X and go to the Clubhouse

Do **not** stay at the shelter as it does not provide protection from the lightning.

If necessary the players from the distant parts of the course will be driven back to the clubhouse by carts via the cycle track.
