



LOCAL RULES – Updated version as of July 20th

1. The only Out of Bounds is defined between holes No. 5 and 6, is marked by white stakes and line and applies to the 6th hole only. While playing the 5th hole the white stakes are **immovable obstructions**.
2. Water hazards and lateral water hazards are marked by yellow and red stakes and lines.
3. Immovable obstructions are all items and objects by the Definition, especially all parts of the irrigation system, all artificial roads and paths including the sides and young trees with supporting stakes and/or marked by blue ribbon including the planting area.

The areas marked by white lines immediately adjoining the artificial paths have the same status as the paths – they are obstructions and not ground under repair and they shall be treated as a **single object** with the path for the relief procedure.

4. Stones in bunkers are movable obstructions.

Cables lying on the ground are movable obstructions.

White stakes with yellow tops are only marking parts of the irrigation system in the deep rough and are movable obstructions.

5. Ground under repair is marked by circled white lines.

Penalty for breach of local rule: Stroke play – two penalty shots

DISTANCE MARKINGS

All the painted distances are measured in meters to the “T” trigger point at the front of the greens including the distances at the par 3 tee boxes.

The permanent markers (disks, stakes) do not provide exact yardage and are to be treated as general guideline indicators only.

CARE OF THE COURSE

Please repair pitch marks, replace divots, rake bunkers and take care of the course.

The rakes should be left outside bunkers.
